

Being an ally is more than being sympathetic and feeling bad for those who experience discrimination. An ally is willing to act with, and for, others in pursuit of ending oppression and creating equality. Real allies are willing to step out of their comfort zones. Those who decide to undertake the ally role must recognize and understand the power and privileges that one receives, accepts, and experiences and they use that position to act for justice (Akbar, 2020).

UPDATE, TIPS, AND HINTS FROM THE ASCL



Needing more SA kits:

A medical facility can request additional SA kits by contacting the ASCL. Please contact them before reaching a critically low quantity to allow for possible lags in shipping time.

Unable to draw blood?

After collecting all other samples in the kit, have the patient orally rinse with water and/or brush their teeth, if possible. Collect buccal swabs. You can either cross out "Known Blood Sample" on the provided envelope and write in "Buccal Swabs" to use that envelope, or label a separate one for this purpose.

Swabs:

Do I need to use a swab dryer?

No. The ASCL asks that swabs be air-dried when possible before repackaging. If you use a swab dryer, guard against cross-contamination between swabs.


Do swabs need to be 100% dry before I package them? No-as long as they are packaged in breathable paper-NOT plastic.


Do I need to put swabs back in the sleeves they come in? No. Placing them loosely inside the provided envelopes is perfectly fine.

FORNIX VERGE INTROITUS OH MY!

The vaginal fornix is the recess that is Our Wonderful formed between the margin of the cervix and the vaginal wall. Normally, it is collapsed, so that the anterior wall is touching the posterior wall. With a vaginal speculum, clinicians can see the inferior end of the cervix, the vaginal fornices, and the external os.








Vaginal introitus An introitus is any kind of opening or entrance

Distally, the anal verge is defined by the visible anus and its entry into the anal canal. Between the anal verge and the anorectal ring are two other landmarks: the intersphincteric groove and the dentate line


